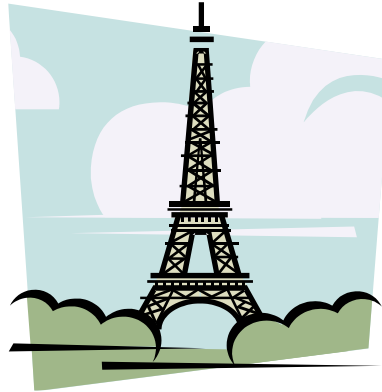


Romancing a Language: French, Fast & Furious (actually Friendly)

Fr 101 is a hybrid course that will allow students to progress through the first semester of French during the second 8 weeks of the semester. We will meet three days a week and have additional regular assignments on-line. Students must therefore have regular access to the internet. Students will learn to communicate in everyday situations, gain an understanding of French-speaking cultures around the world, and develop “survival-level” skills within such cultures. Students should expect to achieve a Novice-high level in all areas of communication in French by the end of the semester. The textbook is *Français-monde*, along with on-line access to “myfrenchlab”.

Students are expected to not be afraid to learn a new language, which includes making mistakes, being occasionally frustrated, and getting plenty of things wrong.
