

GREK 1120. Greek II

Course Description

This course continues the study of the historic Greek language and culture. The aims of this course are to continue to build basic skills in reading, writing, and comprehension in order to read authentic Greek texts with the help of a dictionary. Students will also continue to study the historical factors behind the developments of the Hellenic world and its texts. Prerequisite: Satisfactory completion of Beginning Greek I, or Instructor's permission.

Student Learning Outcomes

1. Build upon a basic knowledge of Greek grammar.
2. Build upon a basic-level Greek vocabulary.
3. Read and understand short, basic, and authentic Greek texts.
4. Accurately translate short, basic, and authentic Greek texts.
5. Develop knowledge of grammar and vocabulary to analyze authentic Greek texts.
6. Obtain an enhanced understanding of the historical development of the Greek language.
7. Identify patterns of cultural behavior or customs in the Hellenic world.
8. Be able to discuss a variety of issues related to the Hellenic culture.
