I have been teaching Chinese as a second language since 2010. In my Chinese language classes, I adopted a student-centered approach in which students are given plenty of opportunities to actually communicate in Chinese meaningfully. I am very passionate about teaching language and culture, and willing to work with all students who are enthusiastic about learning Chinese language and culture. Students often appreciate my energetic teaching style as well as great patience.

Before joining UNM, I taught a good variety of undergraduate Chinese language courses in the College of William and Mary (Williamsburg, VA), including regular beginning level to upper-intermediate level classes, Chinese for heritage speakers, summer intensive classes, and beginning business Chinese (for alumni). I also taught Chinese classes at all levels including AP Chinese with Virtual Virginia, a fully online course program provided by the Virginia Department of Education.

My postgraduate studies focused on curriculum and instructions in foreign languages with a special concentration on Chinese language education. My teaching and research interests focus on teaching Chinese as a second language, including the following areas:

- Chinese phonetic pedagogy
- Chinese grammar pedagogy
- Chinese behavioral culture
- Task-based language teaching and learning
- Curriculum design
- Technology integration and online learning

My recent-completed textbook *Acting Chinese: An Intermediate-Advanced Course in Discourse and Behavioral Culture* is set to be published in August 2020 with Routledge.

After joining FLL in 2016, I served as the Chinese Program Undergraduate Advisor in spring semesters in 2017, 2018, and 2019. For 2019-2020, 2020-2021, 2021-2022 academic years I have continued serving as the Chinese Advisor. In the meanwhile, I have been the Faculty Advisor to the Chinese Language and Culture Club since fall 2016.

In September 2018 I founded the Chinese Language Teachers Association of New Mexico, and have been serving as the president since then. The purpose of the CLTA-NM is to promote quality teaching of Chinese language and culture at all educational levels, to enhance career development and provide a networking platform for Chinese language teachers, and to disseminate pedagogical development and innovations. In 2019 I joined the Board of the New Mexico Organization of Language Educators (NMOLE) and have been serving on the Board. In September 2020 I was elected as the President-elect for New Mexico Organization of Language Educators (NMOLE), and in September 2021 I was elected as the President for NMOLE.
